Bill C-7 proposes to expand the provision of Medical Assistance in Dying in Canada, putting many individuals and groups in jeopardy. We should all inform ourselves on this issue and commit to writing our Member of Parliament urging the defeat of this bill and promotion of good palliative care in our Country.

HEALING MASS

Catholics believe that healing occurs during all Masses. Within the Mass, the Sacrament of the Anointing for the healing of our body, soul, and spirit will be administered. During the Healing Mass we must remain open to the Holy Spirit and invite Him into our hearts in order for healing to take place. The sacrament has been practiced since the time of the Apostles (see James 5:14-15). Jesus commissioned the 'apostles' to preach the good news to the people for a true repentance of their sins, cast out demons and anoint them with the oil of healing (Mt. 6:12-13). The Primary aim of the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is the healing of those who are sick. It may involve physical healing, spiritual healing – forgiveness of sins, or promise of restoration. Our Church is arranging a Healing Mass as part of our Advent journey on Thursday, Dec. 17, 2020 at 7:00 pm. I highly recommend you all to come for the celebration of the Healing Mass and Sacrament of the Anointing to experience the love and compassion of our Lord.
