THE TRAGEDY UNFOLDING IN UKRAINE continues to occupy our thoughts and prayers. I mentioned in last week's Vineyard various organizations that are providing humanitarian aid. The Diocese of Peterborough has made a substantial donation through Catholic Near East Welfare Association. I also noted relief efforts underway through Development and Peace – Caritas Canada and Aid to the Church in Need. This week I am happy to include the Knights of Columbus who have members on the ground in Poland who are already aiding refugees. POPE FRANCIS HAS SENT TWO CARDINALS to represent him in Ukraine and neighbouring countries as the humanitarian crisis grows.
