

SOUTHERN AFRICAN NATIONS THREATENED BY ACUTE MALNUTRITION - "The UN's Children's Fund (UNICEF) calls for urgent funding to scale up programmes across the six drought-affected countries in Southern Africa whose conditions have led to the severe acute malnutrition of nearly 300,000 children. In Lesotho, Malawi, Namibia, Zambia, and Zimbabwe, UNICEF highlights, 7.4 million children are living in child food poverty, of which over 2 million are surviving on extremely poor diets that include at most two food groups. Climate shocks in Southern Africa, UNICEF cautions, are dramatically impacting vulnerable children by dramatically lowering the quantity, diversity, and quality of available food, disrupting access to clean and safe water, and exposing children to life-threatening childhood diseases including diarrhea."
